### HOUSE WINES

#### WHITE WINE

**W01 - L'Artista Sauvignon Blanc, Chile - £12.50**

A typically fresh, lively Sauvignon Blanc with light gooseberry aromas and flavours.

**W02 - Griffin Ridge White**

**Vin de Pays d'Oc, France - £12.50**

An ideal house wine, quite dry, fresh & clean with good weight. It has 20% Chardonnay in the make-up, an easy drinking wine.

#### RED WINE

**R01 - L'Artista Merlot, Chile - £12.50**

Wonderfully intense with luscious plum flavours. Succulent and fruity.

**R02 - Griffin Ridge Red**

**Vin de Pays d'Oc, France - £12.50**

A house wine which has been blended to be soft and fruity. It is medium bodied and can be drunk with or without food.

#### ROSE

**B01 - Griffin Ridge Rosé Vin de Pays d'Oc, France - £12.50**

Pink rosé petal colour with a fresh nose of raspberry aromas. Ideal for just drinking by itself or matched with salads or white meat dishes.

### CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

**S01 - Prosecco, Italy - £18.50**

Crystal clear with a hearty white froth and a fine perlage. Fresh, fragrant aromas of peach, citrus and tropical fruits. Delicately soft and harmonious on the palate.

**S02 - Collet Brut Champagne, France  
£28.50**

Golden in colour, robust and well-structured with a long finish. It has a minimum of three years of cellaring before being shipped.

#### WHITE

**W03 - San Valentino Pinot Grigio, Italy  
£14.00**

Straw yellow in appearance, this is a generous, well-balanced wine with rich, fruity fragrances with a crisp freshness on the palate.

**W04 - Whistling Duck Chardonnay, Australia  
£14.00**

A fruit driven nose of lycee & pomegranate with definite lime characteristics. The lively palate has good fruit flavour balanced by soft, subtle oak and fresh acidity with a long lasting and satisfying finish.

**W05 - Whistling Duck Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, Australia - £14.00**

Pale straw in appearance showing vibrant green tinges. The aromatic nose that leaps out of the glass and develops with intensity shows concentrated lime juice flavours, lemons and hints of underlying spice.

#### RED

**R03 - Whistling Duck Shiraz, Australia  
£14.00**

Aromas of ripe plum fruit with hints of spice and subtle oak. Soft tannins and ripe fruit flavours combine to give depth and length on the palate.

**R04 - Marques del Atrio Tempranillo, Spain  
£14.00**

Deep red, clean and bright. Persistent aromas of red fruit and elegant spicy notes. In the mouth, we find pleasant tannins that provide complexity to a long aftertaste.

**R05 - Chateau Haut-Grelot Premières Côte de Blaye, France - £18.50**

A great bouquet of soft ripe berry fruit giving way to an elegant rich and deep flavoured palate.
